



# Sauna products made of copper

It is recommended to empty the container after use and it should be cleaned regularly with neutral soap and clean water. In humid air, copper mold, better known as patina, forms on the surface of the copper.

That is why our copper objects used in the sauna have been treated with colorless varnish. This slows down patination and keeps the products in a new color for longer. In time, however, patination inevitably begins, and then the article must be periodically polished with a copper polish. If necessary, the varnish treatment can also be renewed, e.g. with colorless spray varnish.

A microfiber cloth can also be used to remove fingerprints.
