

Linen Sauna Products

- Wash linen products separately from other laundry before first use and separate dark ones from whites.
- The first wash may loosen the lint.
- Wash the linen items always separately from other laundry and separate dark ones from whites.
- Wet the textiles to a thorough finish before washing, especially the linen terry cloth (then the water dispensed by the machine will not be absorbed into the textiles, more water will be left for washing and rinsing off the loose fiber).
- Straighten and straighten the textiles to dry on a string.
- Mangle smooth linen textiles when wet.
- Linen does not require a machine prewash program; it just wastes textiles.
- Washing temperature is usually 60 ° C (check the product washing instructions).
- Plenty of water reduces wrinkling during washing.
- With a slow washing rhythm and a high-water limit, lint detachment in the first washes can be reduced (so-called light spinning program).
- Detergent bleaches lighten natural linen quickly.
- Avoid prolonged spinning, which may result in permanent wash wrinkles.
- Check the lint screen before and after washing according to the machine manufacturer's instructions, especially before and after the first wash of the new product.
- Straighten the textiles immediately after washing and hang to dry on a string.
- Avoid tumble drying as it consumes natural fibers.
